## Summer term assessments -

Well done to Year 6 for their calm and diligent approach to their KS2 SATS assessments last week. Thank you to all staff who have worked hard to ensure that the children were well prepared for their tests.

The remaining classes, Years 1-5, will have summer assessments in Reading, Maths and SPAG in June.

Also please note, Year 1 will be assessed on their phonics knowledge using the 2024 Phonics Screening assessment.

Year 4 will be assessed on their speed and knowledge of the 'times tables' using the Multiplication Tables Checker.

Reception Class will be assessed according to the Foundation Stage Profiles.
