**D-Day 80<sup>th</sup> Anniversary** - The anniversary of D-Day Landings was celebrated in school on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> June with a commemorative lunch of Fish & Chips. Your children looked amazing dressed as war veterans, servicemen, evacuees and home front workers. During the assembly we prayed that our world would become more peaceful and wars would cease.

<u>Mass for the Feast of The Sacred Heart of Jesus</u> -June is the month devoted to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, this Feast Day is celebrated on June 7<sup>th</sup> so we attended Mass today.

<u>Values: Love – Respect -Honesty</u> - 'Sweet Heart of Jesus' is our special hymn to the Sacred Heart. We encourage the children to have a 'sweet heart' and find ways to be kind and good friends to one another. We are working hard to establish our School Values across the school and ensure consistency in breakfast club, after school club, dining room, music room and playground as children often behave differently to different adults and in different settings.

There is now a Class Behaviour Book that any adult can access throughout the school day to record behaviour that we can monitor. We will also become more consistent with Yellow and Red behaviour cards and 'time out' sanctions.

If parents have a concern about behaviour they should speak directly to the school leadership team who will deal with the issues you raise. Please avoid speaking directly or indirectly to other parents or children about behaviour as this can cause offence. Calling out to the children who are playing safely can create a positive environment that all will eventually learn to copy.

**Safeguarding** - To help your children Year 2, 3 and 4 will participate in workshops from Unicorn Theatre Online of Roald Dahl's 'The Magic Finger'. These workshops will allow them to explore relationships, respecting differences and recognise and model respectful behaviour. These workshops will be led by the class teachers and will begin next week.

Year 5 and 6 will have Drama Workshop next Tuesday about 'keeping safe', please check letter from Mrs Moore given to children today.
